The 2nd Technical Meeting of the CLIMEPORT project was held on 14th October at the Piraeus Port Authority SA (PPA SA) head offices, in Greece. The CLIMEPORT project is a 36-month project jointly funded by the European Fund for Regional Development (FEDER) of the European Union,

Except PPA SA in the CLIMEPORT project participate as well the APV - Port Authority of Valencia which is the leader of the project, APBA - Port of Algeciras Bay, APM - Port of Marseille Fos Authority, LK- Port of Koper, APL- Port Authority of Livorno, AVEN- Valencian Regional Agency of Energy (Spain), GOLEA- Goriška Local Energy Agency (Slovenia) and ITE- Electrical Technology Institute (Spain).

The main objectives of the CLIMEPORT project is the Mediterranean ports' contribution to climate change mitigation, as well as to develop tools and good practises for the achievement of a greenhouse gas emissions footprint, the limitation of greenhouse gas emissions related to port activities, and the promotion of renewable energies according to the International Standards. During the 2nd Climeport project Partners' Meeting, technical issues were discussed regarding the development and validation of a common methodology among project partners for the diagnosis of the greenhouse gases generated at the participating ports related to port activities.
